

## Comparison of Treaty Land Entitlement Shortfall Calculations

Land Amount

182,943 acres



"Treaty Land Entitlement" or "TLE" means the amount of reserve land to which Peguis First Nation is entitled based on the terms of Treaty 1 signed in 1871.

"TLE Shortfall" means the amount of TLE less the amount of Reserve land set apart for the First Nation, i.e. the St. Peter's Reserve.

"Date of First Survey" or "DOFS" refers to the

date upon which Canada completed a legal survey of the first land set apart as reserve for the First Nation. In the case of Peguis, the survey began in September of 1873 and was completed in the spring of 1874.
